### CLOSE TO THE EDGE: THE BIRTH OF HIP-HOP ARCHITECTURE

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Hip-Hop, the dominant cultural movement of our time, was established by the Black and Latino youth of New York's South Bronx neighborhood in the early 1970s. Over the last five decades, hip-hop's primary means of expression—deejaying, emceeing, b-boying, and graffiti—have become globally recognized creative practices in their own right, and each has significantly impacted the urban built environment

CLOSE TO THE EDGE: THE BIRTH OF HIP-HOP ARCHITECTURE – explores a design movement that embodies the collective creative energies native to young denizens of urban neighborhoods. Its designers produce spaces, buildings, and environments that translate hiphop's energy and spirit into built form.

This exhibit was curated by Sekou Cooke, an architect, researcher, educator, and curator born in Jamaica and based in Charlotte, NC. He is the newly appointed Director of the Master of Urban Design program at UNC Charlotte and a recipient of the 2021/2022 Nasir Jones HipHop Fellowship at the Hutchins Center for African & African American Research at Harvard University.
